

## About the House

Cornwall House is one of three girls boarding houses on campus, with students from Years 7-13. We have 50 boarders from Years 7-11 in the main house, and a separate Annexe for up to 21 Sixth formers, with their own kitchen, common room and laundry room. We also have up to 70 flexi boarders who can come and stay between seven to ten nights a year.

Food is important to life as a boarder and we have several special suppers a week, and events such as Burns Night and Celebration of Difference. We also take part in lots of inter-house competitions, such as the house photo competition and baking competition; our girls love a bit of healthy competition!
